FROM THE GLOBAL DIRECTOR'S DESK

How many life altering conversations have you had? God uses all kinds of people and circumstances to adjust our paths, but I can only remember a few times that one brief encounter significantly adjusted my journey. In the Fall of 2024 I was introduced by a new friend to one of the leading strategic development voices in the USA context. He asked me questions about Christian Endeavor for thirty-eight minutes. (Yes, he was that specific!) Following that time he looked me straight in the eye and said, "God has done an incredible work through Christian Endeavor . . . He NEEDS Christian Endeavor more than ever, but your structure must be changed for you to make the impact that God has designed for it to make." WOW!

I was expecting some thoughtful and calculated insights from this meeting, what I received launched our Executive Committee and team members into countless hours of prayer and preparation. We designed a restructuring plan to provide more global leaders a voice, to clarify our message and branding, to provide quicker delivery of coaching and materials, and to ultimately impact even more youth, adults leaders, and local churches around the world. It went through nine drafts and rewrites before it was approved! 2025 will forever be known in the archives of Christian Endeavor as the year of the most significant reorganization in its 145 year history. This reorganization occurred while continuing to deliver meaningful resources, coaching, and encouragement to a network that has now reached sixty countries. By God's grace, the structure is now in place to see the CE Movement expand into 100 countries by 2031. Never underestimate what God can do through one simple conversation!

A HISTORIC MOMENT: UNITY AND CLARITY FOR GLOBAL IMPACT

After nine drafts, countless hours of prayer, and input from leaders across more than 60 countries, fall 2025 marked the most significant reorganization in Christian Endeavor's 145-year history.

The decisions were clear and decisive:

1. "Christian Endeavor" formally adopted as our unified legal name worldwide.
2. Six global regions restructured into eight strategic regions, giving more leaders a voice and bringing coaching and resources closer to the ground.
3. Governance streamlined across the entire network — built to move faster, reach further, and serve better.

Every structural decision was made in service of one thing: more young people, in more places, encountering the gospel and growing into the spiritual leaders their communities need.

Leaders from across CE's global network gathered, deliberated, and voted — unanimously. That unity was itself a testament to what God has been building through CE for generations. The structure is now in place. The direction is clear. And the next chapter — 100 nations by 2031 — has begun.

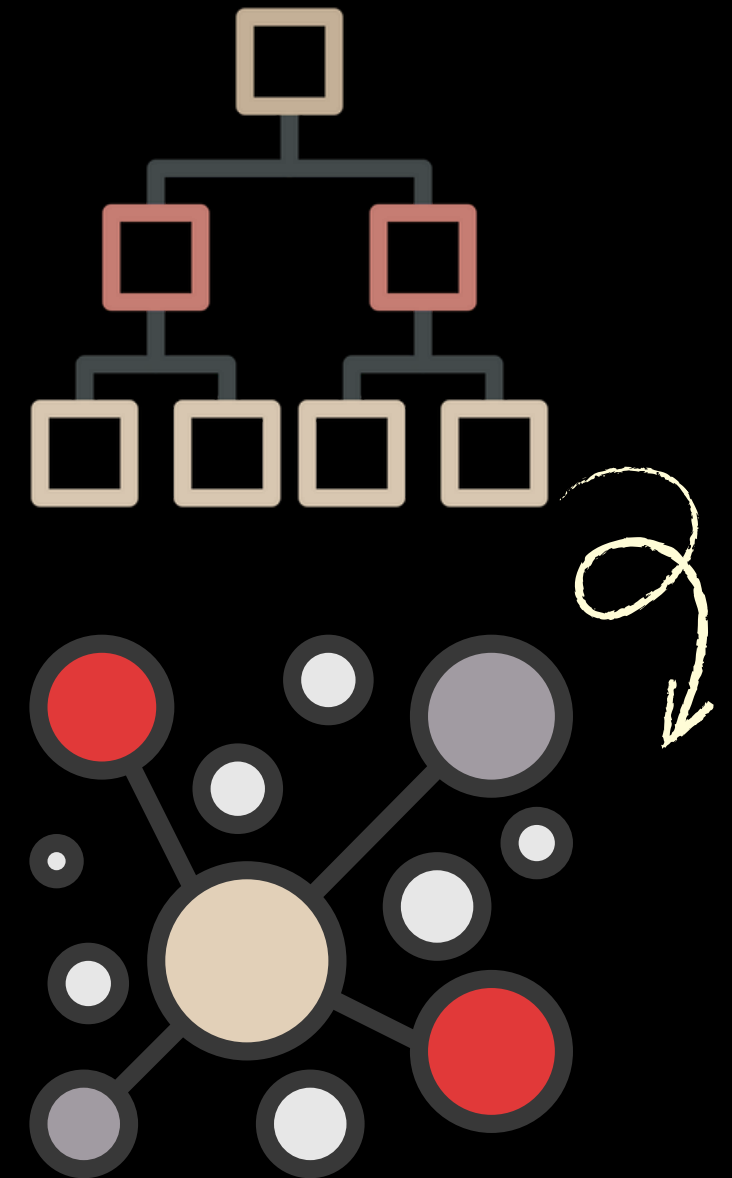


ORGANIZATION STEWARDING A MOVEMENT

The restructuring process of fall 2025 gave CE something more than a new governance framework – it gave us a shared vocabulary for what we are. Leaders across our global network aligned around a conviction that has always been true of CE: **we are an organization that stewards a movement.**

In practical terms, this means CE holds two things in tension simultaneously. The organizational side showed up in fall 2025 as concrete decisions: a unified legal name, eight strategic global regions replacing six, and clearer lines of accountability across 60+ countries. The movement side is what those decisions protect and accelerate – the fluid, Spirit-driven spread of CE's discipleship model into churches, communities, and the lives of young people who don't yet know Christ.

Neither works without the other. Structure without movement becomes bureaucracy. Movement without structure becomes noise. The 2025 restructuring was our commitment to hold both with excellence, efficiency, and faithfulness to what God is doing through CE.





MISSION

Christian Endeavor is a global interdenominational, intercultural, gospel-centered Church movement that develops advocates who intentionally empower youth to commit to Christ and engage their faith.

VISION

We envision Christian Endeavor Advocates growing the movement (deep and wide) by connecting 10,000 affiliate churches to impact 100 nations by 2031.

NETWORK

CE'S NEW 8 REGIONS



In 2025, CE spread into Haiti, Dominican Republic, Madagascar, Zambia, Ethiopia, and Bhutan. We also had an online training with leaders in Myanmar. In addition, Josh met with leaders in Haiti, Canada, and with leaders from across the Caribbean. From all these, a small group has started in Madagascar. There is also follow up interest from Zambia. Trainings for the next level with leaders are happening in 2026 with leaders from Bhutan and Ethiopia.

In 2025, the CE Network reached a landmark: 60 countries and growing. The historic restructuring of fall 2025 brought even greater clarity to how that network is organized — six global regions reshaping into eight strategic regions, each designed to bring leadership, coaching, and resources closer to the ground where the movement is actually happening.

New Countries Join the Movement

CE's expansion into a new country rarely happens by accident — it happens through intentional, in-person investment. A trained CE advocate travels to a new region and gathers leaders from multiple local churches for a hands-on introduction to the CE model. These aren't passive seminars. Leaders leave equipped with a proven discipleship framework, a clearer vision for youth ministry, and a network of peers now on the same mission. But the launch is just the beginning. What follows is sustained virtual coaching that keeps those leaders activated, connected, and growing. A country doesn't just get introduced to CE, it gets brought into the movement. This is CE's expansion strategy in its simplest form: equipped people reproducing what they received, in new places, with new leaders, for the next rising generation.



2025 CE PRAYER DAY

Every year on February 2, CE communities across our network gather for CE Prayer Day — a global, youth-led prayer initiative that unites the movement across cultural and national boundaries. Each nation participates authentically, shaping the themes and expressions of prayer in ways that reflect its own context. The result is something rare: an event when the diversity of the CE movement becomes visible as unity — young people on every continent interceding together for the church, for their communities, and for one another.

In 2025, CE Lebanon gathered at their camp for a day that embodied exactly what this movement is about. Young people led. They worshipped, interceded, and pressed into God together — not as an audience, but as participants. The energy was alive. The faith was real. And the leaders in the room got to witness the next generation doing what CE always believed they can do: lead the church in prayer.

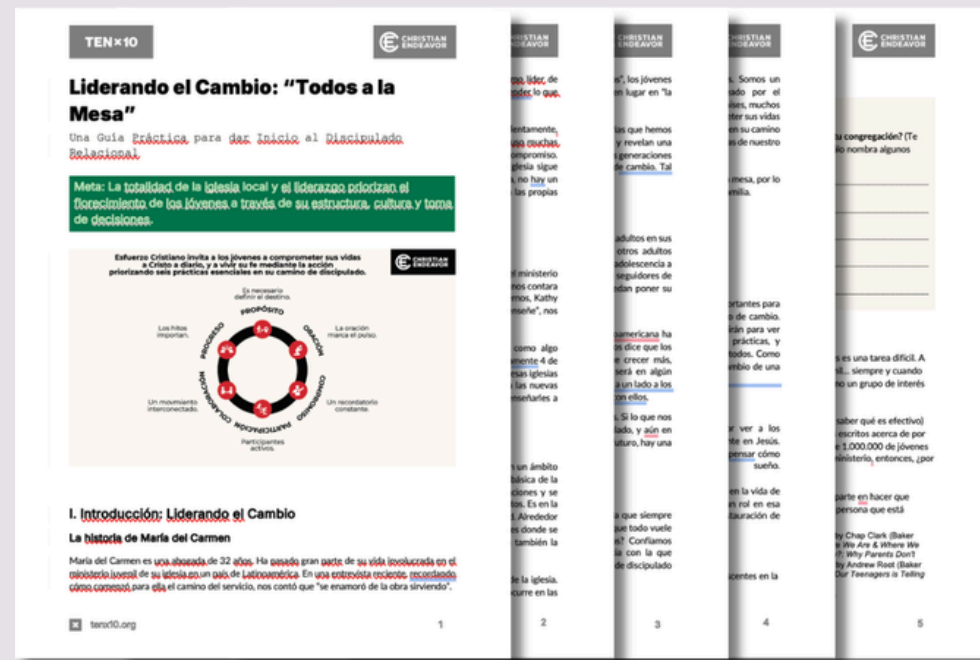
NEW STARTER KIT

Through generous funding from TENx10, CE developed a Hippos to Honeybees Starter Kit in 2025. This comprehensive resource brings CE's discipleship heart to life through a compelling analogy: helping young people transition from passive consumers (hippos) to active contributors (honeybees) in their local churches and God's Kingdom mission. Complete with practical training booklets, professional videos, and dynamic youth group activities, this kit provides churches with fresh, tangible tools to activate young believers. While designed with US congregations in mind, this resource is available to churches worldwide who are eager to embrace this transformative discipleship approach.



LATINE FIELD GUIDE

TENx10



Through a partnership with TENx10, Christian Endeavor launched the Latine Field Guide—a relational discipleship resource and training video designed for Spanish-speaking youth workers.

This positions CE to connect more deeply with Hispanic churches across the United States and to strengthen, align, and expand its work in Spanish-speaking countries throughout Latin America, Spain, and beyond.

The Latine Field Guide equips leaders and helps more young people experience Christian Endeavor’s mission in their own language and culture.

LEADERSHIP

Movements rise or fall by the quality of their leadership.

One of CE's most beautiful realities is that our leaders come from every corner of the globe — different mother tongues, cultures, traditions, and contexts. They understand time differently, plan differently, and envision the local church differently. And yet our unity in Christ, our shared conviction in Scripture's authority, and our unwavering passion for the next generation make genuine collaboration not just possible, but fruitful.

Investing in those leaders has always been central to how CE operates. Every training event, every regional gathering, every new country launch carries this as a non-negotiable: CE leaders aren't just trained in methodology — they're seen, encouraged, and poured into as people. That relational investment is the foundation on which everything else CE does is built.

What 2025 added was greater intentionality and structure. Through the historic restructuring, "Leadership" became a formally named priority — strengthening the foundation and CE's commitment to raise up Biblically-sound, God-honoring leaders across its network. The road is now paved for stronger relationships, deeper accountability, and a clearer pathway for developing these sorts of leaders at every level of the movement.

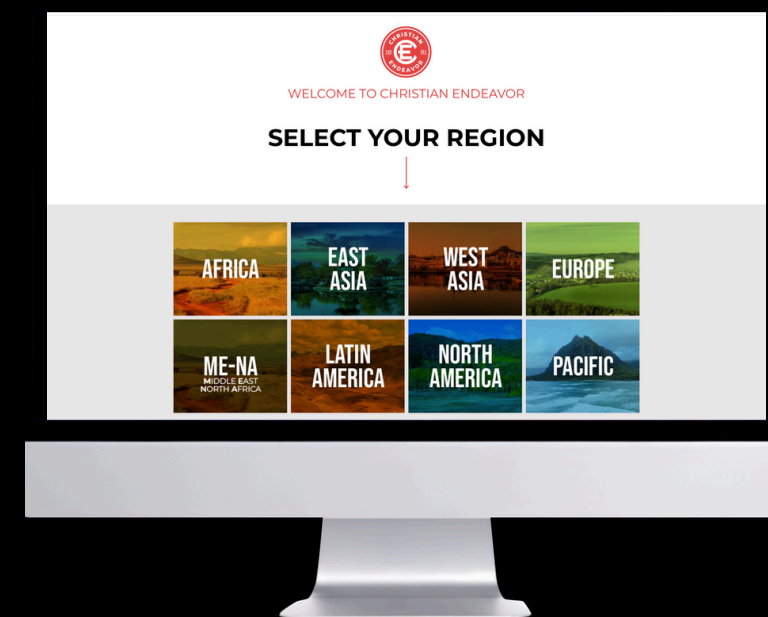
COMMUNICATION

2025 brought significant clarity to how CE speaks to and connects with its global network.

An upgraded website launched — cleaner, stronger, and built with the future in mind. One of the first steps taken was the introduction of regional sections aligned with CE's new eight global regions, laying the groundwork for increasingly contextualized communication in the years ahead. The vision is a website that doesn't just describe CE globally, but speaks meaningfully into each regional context. That work is underway.

Alongside the website, CE's social media presence and monthly newsletter were consolidated under one unified CE identity — one voice, one brand, one movement. The newsletter itself was reworked from the ground up to reflect the true heartbeat of CE: stories of impact from across the global network, the movement of God through youth and leaders in 60+ countries, and content that reminds our community why this work matters.

COACHING

CE identifies, trains, and supports local leaders who can bring Christian Endeavor to their communities. We're calling these leaders advocates. They might be a pastor wanting to start a CE group in their church, a youth worker in a region where CE has never existed, or a long-time CE volunteer ready to help neighboring churches discover this model of youth discipleship.



MARSHALL ISLANDS

- Deacon Sladen Jieta leads the Christian Endeavor movement across the Marshall Islands, impacting 7,000 youth in Pacific churches and 11 U.S. states.
- A 2025 CE gathering brought over 2,000 youth, showing the movement's rapid growth.
- Under his leadership, youth once unwelcome in churches are now actively engaged, bringing their Bibles and honoring God.



TENNESSEE, USA

- CE Advocates Kevin & Amy Potter are empowering students with the CE discipleship strategy in central Tennessee.
- Since connecting with CE in October, they've been studying, implementing, and sharing the ministry with local churches.

DENOMINATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

One of the most strategic expressions of CE's coaching work is serving entire denominational networks — not only individual churches or youth workers, but the full ecosystem of a denomination's youth ministry.

Evangelical Congregational Church For more than five years, CE has partnered with the Evangelical Congregational (EC) denomination to provide strategic coaching across their network of 140 US churches and 450+ congregations worldwide. What began as individual relationships has grown into something deeper — a trusted, ongoing collaboration focused on equipping EC youth leaders and helping local churches build youth discipleship that actually works. The fruit has been real: stronger leaders, healthier ministries, and a denomination more deeply invested in the next generation.



**Rosedale Network
of Churches**

Rosedale Network of Churches In 2025, CE formalized a new partnership with the Rosedale Network of Churches (RNOC) — an evangelical Anabaptist denomination of 118 congregations across 28 states. RNOC is looking to CE as a primary support and equipping resource for youth ministry across their network. The partnership is young, but the momentum is already tangible. In the words of Darren Peachey, RNOC's Conference Pastor: **"I hear a buzz in the air regarding youth ministry."**

That buzz is what CE exists to cultivate — and these two denominations are proof that when the right support and coaching shows up, churches and youth leaders come alive.

PARTNERSHIPS

There are 4 billion people on earth under the age of 30. That number isn't an abstraction — it's the horizon CE is working toward. Every young person in that number deserves the chance to hear and respond to the gospel. And no single organization, church, or ministry will get there alone.

That conviction drives CE's intentional investment in strategic partnerships. In 2025, CE formalized partnerships with two significant global ministries: Shaping Student Ministry, which develops youth curriculum on topical and scriptural subjects, and Scripture Union, whose reach into children and young people spans the globe. These aren't casual connections — they are deliberate commitments to link arms with organizations whose mission aligns with CE's and whose strengths complement our own.

CE also continues to deepen its investment in partnerships like the Global Youth Coalition, which connects youth discipleship organizations to eliminate duplication in underresourced regions, and TENx10, which works to stop the exodus of youth from the church. And CE's growing relationship with the Next Gen Global Leaders Collab — a network whose collective impact reaches over one billion people — reflects our conviction that the scale of what God is doing through youth ministry globally is far larger than any one organization can steward alone.

Thank you for partnering with Christian Endeavor — so that together, we can empower the next generation to advance the gospel for Christ and the Church.
